



## Contest Rules

Thank you for daring to jump to change the lives of teen parents and their babies. This is the inaugural event of The Trampoline TapOut. Our goal is to encourage advocacy for teen parents, build community and raise needed for funds for the Rosemary's Babies program so we can continue to build our programming and serve teen parent families in Greater Cincinnati.

### GET REGISTERED

All teams must register via the Rosemary's Babies Company website. Each team then chooses a team name, team color.

### SPONSORSHIP

**By competing in the competition you and your partner have agreed to a minimum sponsorship amount of \$200, paid to Rosemary's Babies Co by NOVEMBER 8, 2018.**

To show our appreciation, your sponsors will receive a FREE Ticket to the event or an RBC wristband. These items will be in your care and it is up to you to request more.

Though your minimum contribution is \$200, we encourage you to set a fundraising goal that exceeds this expectation.

### EVENT DETAILS

**All parties must be registered the day of the event, November 10, 2018 by 10:30 am. Teams who are not registered will be disqualified from the competition.**

**THE EVENT WILL BEGIN PROMPTLY from 11:00 -1:00.**

Participants will jump for 2 hours from 11:00 to 1:00 pm. Participants will change with their partner in 20 minute intervals. A buzzer will sound and then you must immediately switch and begin jumping. If you are not actively jumping within 20 seconds of the switch, *you may be disqualified.*



## Contest Rules

### **TAPOUT**

A participant must be actively moving on the trampoline AT ALL TIMES.

A jump is considered up and down using one foot or both feet. For those with disabilities, you are able to walk on the trampoline. If there is a pause, A REPRESENTATIVE WILL ASK IMMEDIATELY if you are TAPPING OUT.

A horn will buzz three times when a team taps out.

The last team to remain in the competition TAKES IT ALL.

### **TIE BREAKER**

In the case of a tie, the remaining teams will choose one person from the team to jump rope until the final person remains.

**ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST SIGN A RELEASE AND LIABILITY WAIVER**
