

2018 Annual Report: Navigating Our Two's









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Dear Friends,

Thank you for supporting Rosemary's Babies Company (RBC) in 2018 as we "Navigated Our Twos." This year more than 1,500 people attended our events that included our panel Teen Pregnancy: Then, When & Now, our Final Friday event at Pendleton Art Gallery, Legends Showcase & Benefit Gala, our Trampoline TapOut and our Birthday & Leadership Celebration.

We understand our success could not be possible without our community being ambassadors for our organization: donating your time, talents and treasures to our organization. In 2018, we superseded our goal of supporting 12 families in the tri-state via our Leadership & Legacy Program. This program in partnership with United Way of Greater Cincinnati supports three generations: teen parent, parent of teen parent and the child.

This is a great achievement for RBC towards creating strategies to eradicate generational parenting and poverty.

2018 HIGHLIGHTS

- Our organization Served 75 Families via in-person support
 - Leadership & Legacy Program: 22 families were served (22 Teens, 22 Babies, 4 Parents)
 - 24/7 Confidant Care: 8 car seats distributed, 10 Emergency Uber Rides, 42 people benefitted from Petals Pantry
 - Levi the Leadership Lion entertained more than 300 people at our Trampoline TapOut & 2nd Anniversary Event
- RBC Leadership Board received more than 30 hours of professional development and education
- In-Kind hours of volunteers more than 5,000 and \$10K of in-kind resources

MEASUREMENTS

These measurements solely focus on our Leadership & Legacy Program. This report measures 16 Program Participants & Families

In 2018, Rosemary's Babies corresponded with 30 families interested in our Leadership & Legacy programming, accepting 22 participants in our Leadership & Legacy Program. 16/22 accepted actively participated up to 30 days past the initial point of contact (Confidante Care); these individuals stopped responding and phone information became invalid. 6 of 22 enrolled in Beech Acres parenting program.


CHARACTERISTICS OF PARTICIPANTS

- 100% of youth participants were between 14-19 vears of age
- 100% of youth participants reported family incomes below 200% of the poverty level
- 86% of program participants were minorities
- 3 of 16 participants were pregnant
- 3 of 16 participants were teen fathers

2 program participants were in foster care. 3 program participants were in independent living through an agency. 7 teen parents lived alone with their child and were 18/19 years of age. 4 teen parents lived with a parent/quardian.






Program Participant's who had


Program Participants who reported health




Pregnant Participants who received adequate prenatal care

MISSION

Rosemary's Babies mission is to help teen parents master the concepts of self-leadership to leave a legacy.

VISION

Our vision is to impact the lives of teen parents in Greater Cincinnati and around the globe in the areas of parenting, education, technology, arts, and leadership while alleviating social determinants that keep the family and their children from being successful.

24/7 CONFIDANT CARE

Confidant Care provides 24/7 virtual support for teen parents and families through any of our social platforms: Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, SnapChat, Text Message/Call, Website, Instagram. Any teen parent and/or a family member are able to use this service for support including support from our Petals Pantry which supplies baby care items and emergency supplies. Uber Emergency Transportation, and Cribs Program in collaboration with Ohio Equity Institute- Safe Sleep Education Training Program.

LEADERSHIP & LEGACY PROGRAM

The Leadership & Legacy Program provides support for three generations: teen parent, parent of the teen parent and their child. Our goal is to support these families by providing support and a plan via the PETALS Track: parenting, education, technology, arts, leadership and alleviating social determinants.

Through this program, **all teen parents and families receive** trauma-informed care and counseling, access to 1:1 mentoring, as well as a tablet that helps the development of their baby.

Note: Our program in partnership with United Way of Greater Cincinnati has a focus on intentionally targeting families who fall 200% below the poverty level.


LEVI THE LEADERSHIP LION


FINANCE
